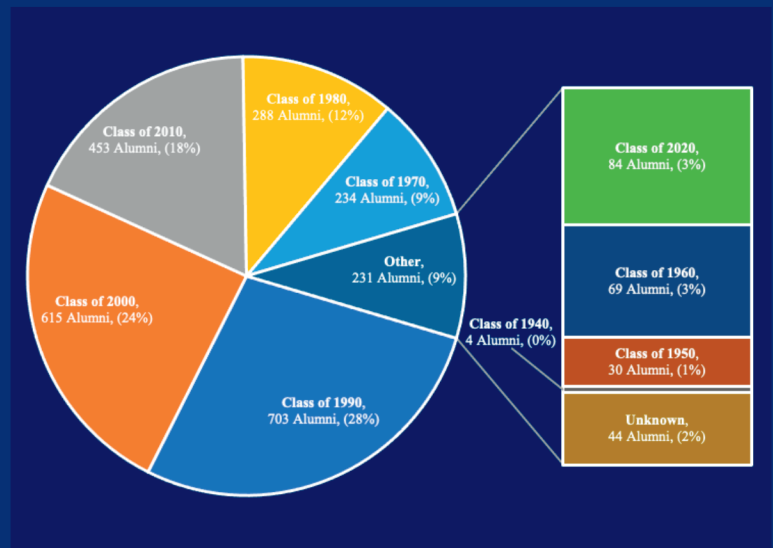

The Atlanta Alumni Chapter of NC A&T was founded in 1960 by six Aggie Alum who set out to unite fellow Aggies in Atlanta. Their primary goal was to be a vessel of support to NC A&T State University. With members from over 20 counties in Metro Atlanta, the chapter has become recognized as one of A&T's top chapters for membership, engagement, annual giving, and scholarship.

The chapter continues to focus on scholarship and was approved for an endowment in 2021. The annual endowment scholarship will provide one Atlanta area student with a full 4-year scholarship.

The Atlanta Chapter Endowment Scholarship was voted on and approved by NC A&T in 2020. Fundraising began in 2021 as leadership decided to focus solely on annual book scholarships until the new fiscal year. Of the \$18,041.88, the ATL Chapter donated **\$3,419.06** to the Chapter endowment scholarship. The Chapter achieved and exceeded all goals except endowment fundraising.

Analysis of Chapter Dues
